authority in probation and parole casework is raised and discussed in terms of the functional approach. Perhaps the broader aspects of the juvenile court law merited more attention. There is no mention of the Youth Authority and Adult Authority developments. It is however encouraging to observe the tendencies for the ever closer integration of correctional social work with the main stream of generic social casework and appropriate community organization, as discussed by the author.
