an argument against the use of probation, because with about 70 percent successes, probation is still a very satisfactory method of preventing recurrence of individual crime. Further study is encouraged.

As a statistical study, the method of presentation is commendable. The interpretive material is readable and understandable, unencumbered by a mass of figures and tables. These are presented in the Appendix. The statistical data are well chosen and support the conclusions derived from them. The author is fair and objective in their use.
