The above pleas were all successful in the sense that the jury, in each case voted on Darrow's side—not necessarily an instance of persuasion in the proper sense. Darrow knew how to choose words for their emotional value. He understood the virtue of repetition and of seeming to be personally disinterested. In such respects these pleas are good reading for salesmen! But one would not go to them as to an encyclopedia of scientific knowledge!

Other addresses included here are: "They Tried

to Get Me,"; (In his own defense when Darrow was on trial for attempted bribery of a juror); "John Brown," ("One of the purest and bravest"); "John Peter Altgeld," ("Lover of his fellow men.") "Crime and Criminals," (Before prisoners in Cook County Jail, 1902, on the Warden's invitation.)

The Editor probably included the last title above out of his desire to give readers a fair idea of Mr. Darrow's range. But one wonders what the speaker thought he was doing for the prisoners when he was giving them such an address!
