The author of *Everything Old Is New Again: Justice Scalia's Activist Originalism in Schiro v. Summerlin* (Volume 95, Issue 3), would like to make the following correction:

On p. 792, the author erroneously asserted, "Justice Scalia's *Schiro* opinion does not mention either AEDPA or the federal statute in which it was codified."
